

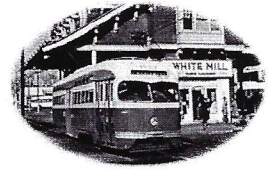

A Message from MTTV Operations Director, Neil Norkaitis.

During training, we failed to review the steps to be taken in case of an accident to us or our visitors.

1. In all cases, notify the Museum person in charge for the day. On weekdays, this is the main office. On weekends, it is the person identified in the list posted on the door at our work bench in the shop.
2. In case of someone needing emergency care because of a serious accident, call 911 first. Try to dispatch someone to the Museum gate to guide the EMT's to the location of the injured.
3. In case of a minor injury, get in touch with "Call A Nurse" per the card on our bulletin board in the shop. Carry one of these cards with you when operating.

After thorough testing, it is deemed that the #1743 is reliable and safe to operate after a person has appropriate training. Cal Blanksteen will be scheduling such training. The addition to the training manual to cover this car is nearing completion.

On Father's Day, June 19, #1743 will operate all day. Rocky Mastrorocko and John Crowley have agreed to endure operating the whole day that day. Anyone wishing to observe and get the feel of how the car rides is welcome to attend.
